- 1. Call to Order: The regular minutes of the St. Petronille Parish Council called to order at 7:03pm

- 7. Commission Reports
 - a. **Religious Education** (Eileen Buccola presented) Highlights from February 13 meeting include:
 - 1. Young Adult/Youth Ministry Gabi
 - Planning high school participation in Joliet Youth Day
 - Inviting middle schoolers and high schoolers to Fish Fry
 - Hunger Awareness is focus with Middle Schooler
 - 2. Religious Ed Julie
 - First communion approaching parent meetings have been held, retreat is April 13.
 - Confirmation scheduled with Bishop Kane March 14; There is a new exam this year. Interviews have gone well; Confirmation planning for 2025 already underway
 - 3. Adult Ministry Tim and Nancy O'Donohue
 - Coordinating with Young Adult/Youth Ministry on March for Life Event in Springfield

- b. **Christian Service** (Rich Cullotta reported). Highlights from December 12 meeting (January meeting was cancelled due to weather) include:
- **GE Walk-in-Ministry** a 15% increase in clients through October 2023 over the same period in 2022; a 39% increase in total services gas, car repairs, Aldi food certificates, and utility assistance
- Ministry of Care 17 Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist to the homebound with 8 people receiving the Eucharist
- PADS Through generous donations through groups and corporations, PADS has been distributing coats
- **SVDP** Request for rents and electric bill are being paid; senior housing available in West Chicago w/ income below \$40,000
- **Bridge Communities** Next Mentor Training is March 2nd. Jim and Trish Lenahan and Mark Shutock will represent St. Petronille.
- ESSE The Glen Ellyn and Aurora sites are doing well. Getting requests from new clients; Executive Director still recruiting for an Activity Aide position, which will rotate from Glen Ellyn to Wheaton as needed
- MC Adopt A Family card drive went well—240 Gift cards \$25 each; school
 adopted ten Mary's Closet families for this program. Excess cards went to PADS
 and Metropolitan Family Services.
- Choose Life The Patients' Rights Council found a speaker addressing end of life issues. Susan Disdomizio is in a new position with the diocese Ministry of Mercy Advisor dealing with end-of-life issues. Will start in two parishes in Feb. or March of '24; The TV streaming program "Formed" has a four-part series on end-of-Life Issues
- **St. Josephine Bakhita Community** (Klovirt Alnar absent). Highlights from October meeting include:
- Bishop Hicks blessed the new St. Josephine Bakhita Hall (formerly known as Colonial Hall) and the Mary's Portico on January 14. Father said the event was very special and was enjoyed by attendees and guests, with dancing and singing by the choir
- c. **Finance** (Tom Kane absent): Highlights from November 16 meeting include:
- Budgeting season is coming up, which means Finance council begins to meet every month. Budget will be presented in April and approved in May.
- Big news: have secured a new Finance Manager Joe Brichetto. Jeff May did a great job filling the gap in the meantime. Baptism by fire, but he's gaining traction.

- Very positive position for parish, both church and school.
- Church: YTD Sunday/Holy Day collections are almost \$500K, which is under budget by \$16K but slightly ahead of prior year by +\$1K; YTD salaries/benefits are \$216K, which is over budget by \$17K (driven by office and support staff salaries because salaries/benefits are up \$18K versus prior year)
- School: Tuition and fee revenues are \$1,746K, which is over budget by \$128K (driven by favorability in registration, tablet, and other fees recognized early in the year but budgeted evenly over 12 months); tuition and fees revenues are above last year by \$181K; Parent Organization funding of \$97K is \$47K ahead of budget but \$26K under prior year; YTD salaries and benefits are \$971K, which is over budget by \$47K (driven by \$105K of school bonuses that were not budgeted)
- d. **Worship** (Joseph Dougherty reported): Highlights from January 16 meeting include:
