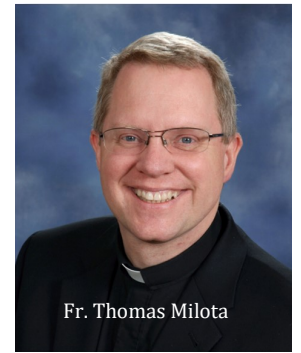

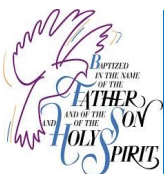

Eucharistic Adoration Every Friday

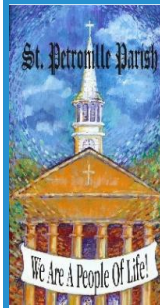


We have the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church every Friday from 3-10pm, 24-hour Adoration on First Fridays following the 8am Mass
