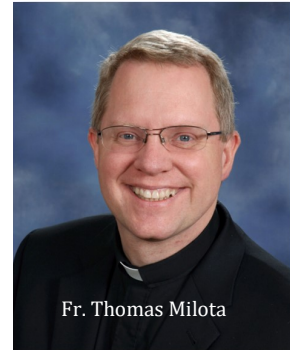
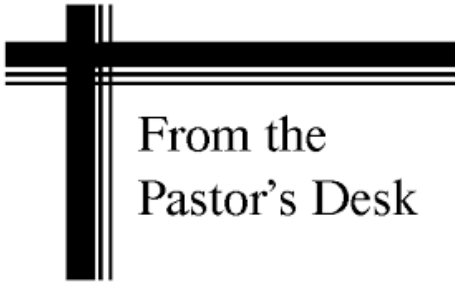

A SAMPLING OF OUR APRIL MARY'S CLOSET CLIENTS:

A young mother living in her car with her three young children. She has a full-time job, but can't afford rent. A family with six children (two sets of twins—one set born in January). This family could not afford to move their belongings from Florida, so they packed what they could fit in their car; the rest they left behind. Two single mothers who had emergency c-sections whose jobs don't provide paid maternity leave. A single father with custody of his young child. He does not receive child support from the child's mother. A family from Mexico who arrived in the U.S. two months ago. She is expecting their second child in June.

A homeless family of six. The father drives an Uber at night; the mother stays home with their four children and works part-time, but her hours were recently cut.

CHOOSE LIFE — Assisted Suicide in Illinois

The Illinois Bishops issued a statement opposing the recently introduced legislation to legalize assisted suicide in Illinois. SB 3499 makes it legal for a physician to prescribe an array of lethal drugs to a person diagnosed with a terminal illness who requests to end his or her life. The legislation brings a range of possible abuses, and poor and those with disabilities are particularly vulnerable. EVERY major national organization that represents people with disabilities is opposed to assisted suicide. We cannot say it any better than the American Medical Association, "Physician assisted suicide is fundamentally incompatible with the physician's role as healer, would be difficult or impossible to control, and would provide serious societal risks." Please go to www.ilcatholic.org or call 217-528-9200 to find out how to contact your local elected official to tell them to vote NO on SB 3499.

Eucharistic Adoration Every Friday

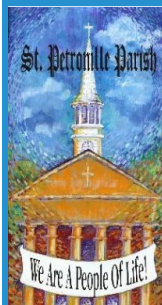


We have the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church every Friday from 3 -10pm, 24-hour Adoration on First Fridays following the 8am Mass
